Important Dates

General Election: November 6, 2018

Voter Registration Deadline: October 16, 2018

Request for Absentee Ballot: October 30, 2018

How many ways can I pre-register?



- **Online:** <https://turbovote.org/> OR www.vote4dc.com
- You will need to provide proof of residence that shows your name and current DC address with your application or the first time you go to vote.
- **In Person & By Mail:** This must be postmarked 21 days before the election and sent to the DC Board of Elections

Can I do same day registration on Election Day?

- In DC you can register and vote on Election Day!
- At the polling place, you must prove both who you are and where you live. The best way to do this is with your valid government issued ID with your current address printed on it.

What is Absentee Voting/ Voting by Mail?

- This allows you to vote by mail if you cannot vote in person on election day.
- You can request a vote-by mail ballot online at <https://vote4dc.com/ApplyInstructions/Absentee>.
- You can complete your application online or download the form and mail to the DC Board of Elections
- Your county auditor will then mail you an absentee ballot

First time Voting on Election Day?

What to bring:

If you registered by mail and did not provide proof of residence in the application bring a form of ID with the name and address of voter

- EX: DC DMV ID, lease, bank statement
- If you don't have ID, don't worry! You can submit a special ballot
