Important Dates

- General Election: November 6, 2018
- Voter Registration Deadline: October 9, 2018
- Request for Absentee Ballot: November 3, 2018 by mail

How many ways can I pre-register?



- **Online:** <https://turbovote.org/> OR <https://olvr.sos.state.oh.us/>
- You will need to provide your Ohio driver's license or state ID number and the last four digits of your SSN.
- **In Person & By Mail:** This must be postmarked 30 days before the election and sent to your local Board of Elections or the Secretary of State's Office.
- You will need to provide your Ohio state driver's license number or the last four digits of your SSN.

First time Voting on Election Day?

What to bring:

Ohio law requires voters to present proof of address when they go to vote.

- EX: Ohio driver's license or ID card, current utility bill, bank statement, etc.
- If you don't have ID on you, don't worry! You can submit a provisional ballot by giving the last four digits of your SSN or providing ID later.

Ohio utilizes a nonpartisan registration system. Instead of choosing a party affiliation at the time of registration, voters are asked on Election Day which party's ballot they would like to cast their vote on.
