## Important Dates

**General Election:** November 6, 2018

**Voter Registration Deadline:** October 19, 2018 online

**Request for Absentee Ballot:** October 26, 2018

### How many ways can I pre-register?



- **Online:** <https://turbovote.org/> OR <https://www.nebraska.gov/apps-sos-voter-registration/>
- You will need to provide your Nebraska driver's license or state ID number.
- **By Mail:** The application must be sent to your local county election office and postmarked by October 19. Find it at <http://www.sos.ne.gov/elec/pdf/vr.pdf>
- **In Person:** Visit your local county election office, the DMV, or another participating state agency by October 26 at 6pm to fill out an application.

### What is a voter registration card?

- The card will have your name, assigned polling location, and voting districts on it.
- Your voter registration card is for your personal reference and not required to vote.

### Where can I vote on Election Day?

### What is Absentee Voting/ Voting by Mail?

- This allows you to vote by mail if you cannot vote in person on election day.
- Anyone in Nebraska can vote absentee! You don't need to provide a reason.

### First time Voting on Election Day?

#### What to bring:

You might want to bring your ID with you just to be safe.

- Nebraska doesn't require voters to show ID, but if you registered by mail and did not provide ID, you will be asked to provide identification.
- EX: Any photo ID, current utility bill, bank statement, etc.
